TIME IS FLYING! DEADLINES ARE APPROACHING!

**Quilt entry forms need to be returned by Aug. 6, or at the latest the meeting, Aug. 10<sup>th</sup>.**

We are reminding members to:

(1) Complete the "Home Tweet Home" Challenge and give it to NJ or let her know the dimensions if you plan on finishing it the night of Sept. 23. This will be a featured exhibit and will be listed in the show book so please complete one if you took the challenge fabric.

(2) Make, bake, construct, sew, build, knit, or quilt an item for the Bazaar. Price (and initial) your own items. Unsold items will leave the show with the donor. Kathryn and Amanda will be collecting items for the Bazaar.

(3) Contribute a Miniature for the Silent Auction. Lavonne and Marlyn will be collecting .

(4) Sell the Raffle Tickets or buy them yourself and give them away.

(5) If you have make a quilt of any size using 2 1/2 " strips, remember to include them when you complete the Entry Form. These will be hanging from the top rail and, as always, make a colorful display to add to the show.

(6) Remember props this year revolve around the "Home Sweet Home" theme, also bird houses, bird cages. Patriotic vignettes will be used also. Anyone have flags of the military branches? Also flags with stands for U.S. and Missouri flags that we can display near special exhibit. The usual props, baskets, plants, misc quilting.

(7) Invite your friends, relatives, organization members, distant cousins once removed, etc. Let's try to beat last year's attendance! With all of the great exhibits there will be something for everyone.

Donna and NJ are working on advertising, newsletters, tv ads, bulk mailings, and general publicity. Lavonne is working on signs for the quilts and the show floor. Micki has helped with tech support.
