## Fat Quarter Baskets

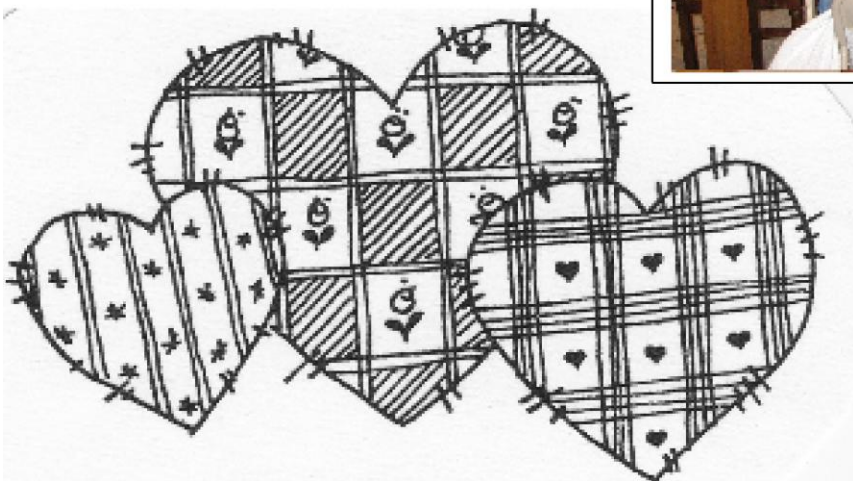
