Peaches & Cream

3/4 c. flour
1 (4 serving size) dry vanilla pudding mix for cooking (NOT instant)
1 tsp baking powder
1 egg, beaten
1/2 c. milk
3 tblsp milk
3 tblsp margarine, melted
1 (16 oz) can peach slices, drained (SAVING 1/3 c. juice)
1 (8 oz) pkg cream cheese, softened
1/2 c. sugar
2 tblsp sugar
1/2 tsp cinnamon

Sift flour, pudding mix and baking powder together. Combine beaten egg with milk and margarine. Add to dry ingredients. Spread in greased 9 x 13 pan. Chop peaches and sprinkle on batter. Beat together cream cheese, 1/2 c. sugar and 1/3 c. peach juice. Pour over peaches and batter. Combine 1 tblsp sugar and cinnamon. Sprinkle over all. Bake at 305 degrees for 45 min.
