
From the President

FRIENDSHIP BLOCK: Christie W collected her blocks and thanked the members for completing blocks for her. Donna B handed out her block packets. Betty Sue S's name was drawn for next month. Since she was absent, Mary Vale J' name was drawn as alternate.

QUILT SHOW: Karen G announced that miniatures should be limited to 12 to 15 inches. Nothing over 16 inches. She needs more quilts for the show and has extra entry forms if needed. The PRESIDENT'S CHALLENGE is due at the September meeting. Michael M has 21 items for the SILENT AUCTION but needs more. Suann C needs more props for the show. Be sure to put your name on each one for safe return. Marty W passed around a food list. She will accept money in lieu of food. Amanda M is having quilt bags made for those who want them. They are \$8.00 each.

SHOW AND TELL: Rita M showed her "Flower Garden". Marty W displayed a blue and white twisted bargello and a John Deere tractor and Iowa Corn Bargello. Norma Jean F showed a small quilt from a prior workshop. Anita C displayed a small quilt for the silent auction. Marlyn M showed a quilt for the children's home named "Garden Twist"; a black and gold quilt from the Block of the Month in Higginsville; an embroidered green and white quilt called "Wildflowers" and two quilt tops. Christie W showed her embroidered log cabin quilt. Ruth T showed us her painted patio pillows, her crazy quilt witches hat and a purple sunbonnet quilt top. Dorothy R showed off a tied quilt which had no batting. Janet E showed a block of the month entitled "Star Struck"; a mystery quilt project named "Mysterious Garden" and a quilt called "Buckeye Beauty". Katherine S showed several tabletoppers she had made as Christmas gifts. Suann C showed a blue and white baby quilt and a twisted bargello made from jelly rolls in oranges and browns.

Lavonne B stated that there are kits available to make name tags for any new members or anyone else in need of one.

PROGRAMS: Kathryn J reported that next month's program will be "Tile Quilts" with Carol J. She then introduced the ladies from the Columbia Guild who gave an informative program on English paper piecing, redwork and applique.
