Karen has questions about Tourism, the fact that they cut our budget by \$2, 000.00 for 2017. Tourism is for developing and marketing of Marshall, we fall under the marketing section. She has been trying to cut advertising in certain places to make up the difference, one being the KC Star ad which is \$1,280.00, lowering the amount of trifolds ordered to 5000 which will cut \$360.00. She wants to keep the radio ad in Warsaw, and cut the Chillicothe ad to maybe 1 printing instead of 2 which would be about \$175.00, since they have a quilt shop in town just make sure they have our trifolds to hand out. Also thinking of making a Facebook page for the Quilt Show.

When the trifolds are printed we need to get some out to the Martin Center so they have the information to give people when they ask about the Show.

A motion was made to change the wording in the Vendor Contracts to read stolen or bad credit cards are the Vendors responsibility, it was second and passed.

Marty and Kathryn volunteered to do Programs for 2018, so if you see or hear of a good program please let them know.

Coconut Layered Dessert

1 cup flour
½ cup of oleo, melted
2 Tbsp. sugar
½ cup pecans, chopped
1 cup coconut
1 (8 ounce) pkg cream cheese
1 cup powdered sugar
1 (8 ounce carton) whipped topping
2 (3 ounce) pkgs coconut cream pudding mix (not instant)
3 cups milk

Mix flour, oleo, sugar and pecans. Press into 13 x 9 inch pain. Bake 15 minutes at 325°F or until lightly browned. Toast coconut in a shallow pan while above mixture is baking. Cream together with mixer the cream cheese and powdered sugar. Fold in one cup whipped topping. Spread on cooled crust. Combine pudding mix with milk and cook. When cool, put on top of other mixture and cover with additional topping. Sprinkle with toasted coconut. Will keep in refrigerator for several days. Stored covered. Serves 12.
